



BHS Booster Board Meeting Minutes

Booster Mission: Supporting the activities, welfare, and education of Beaverton High School students

Meeting Called to Order by Michelle Hebden under authority and responsibility given the Board by the Declaration and Bylaws of the Association, the Board met to:

1) Andrew Kearl Update-

- a. Food Distribution through the district (received funds) - opened Urban Gleaners over the holidays and have some for Beaver Den
- b. Holiday Help - Adopt a family, gift cards running through the school. Boosters can buy gift cards (Winco) and non-perishable food items. Need to reach out the the social workers to see what family needs and need to evaluate how much money Boosters can actually give.
 - i. Up to \$5000 for gift cards from Boosters (if needed). Jenna will coordinate with Social Workers on the exact dollar amount. Boosters approve funds up to \$5000 for this buy only.
- c. Wall/Area for students to “destroy” as part of the construction - do a Beaver Lodge project (like make ceiling tiles for new building).
- d. Andrew to look into how to get an AED for the outside field.
- e. Why does the Pond sell Red Bull... Seems to go against District healthy food guidelines. Probably not much Boosters can do about it.

2). Student Wellness -

- a. Hot Coco/Cuties event - Dec. 16 (Tues) hand out at lunch. 11:30-1:00pm
- b. Beaver Den - need “marketing” and get the word out about what it is and when it’s open and solicit donations. Collect donations at Bball games, collection bins in Beaver Lodge or student center. Set up a Sign Up Genius indefinitely for donations.
- c. Jam the Dam (make a wish foundation) - Boosters sponsors at the \$500 level. Boosters approved for this years event on Feb. 25.

3) . Staff Appreciation -

- a. Soup Event on Friday Dec. 5 - soups, salad, treats. Need a few more volunteers (morning shift 8:30-9:30 set up / 3:00-4:00 clean up / pick up). Should be good for food donations.

4). Concessions -

- a. Dec. 5 is first home Bball game, so Jaime getting indoor concessions set up.
- b. Fall concessions went well. Total Sales - approx. \$30K. Paid out \$10K to clubs.
- c. Most winter concessions slots filled. A couple BBall games need to be filled
- c. Booster Merch sales at all Friday night Bball games (boys or girls).

5). Treasurer

- a. Need to confirm with construction team as to when they need Boosters to buy new equipment for new indoor concessions.
- b. Ann Goldade has been officially added to the Booster bank account as co-Treasurer.
- c. Boosters purchased 180 tickets for soccer playoff games \$1100.

6). Holiday Bazar - was a success and Calvary Church will host again next year - Nov. 21, 2026.
